These arrangements were agreed at the 2013 IUPsyS Executive Committee meeting

Opportunities to contribute to IUPsyS policy and activities

- Affiliated organizations are invited to send an observer to IUPsyS Assembly meetings
- Affiliates will be invited to supply brief reports on matters of mutual interest for IUPsyS Assembly meetings, to be made available or presented to Assembly delegates at the discretion of the Executive Committee.
- Affiliated organizations should be invited to contribute to IUPsyS activities, including consultations, planning events or participation in working groups, where this is of mutual benefit and relevant to their fields of expertise
- Where there are mutual benefits in doing so, the Union may facilitate communication between an Affiliate and the Union's National Members

Mutual support at international meetings

Where appropriate, IUPsyS and the Affiliate should negotiate:

- Mutual registration waivers for conferences or congresses
- Arrangements for running symposia, panels or other events at their respective conferences or congresses
- Arrangements for free exhibition booths or for promotion of future international events

Opportunities for collaboration

Where appropriate, IUPsyS and the Affiliate should consider:

- Mutual networking opportunities within global psychology research, education and practice
- Joint projects or activities where these are to the advantage of both parties
