## IUPsyS Signs Agreement to Lodge its Archives at the Adolph-Würth-Center for the History of Psychology

The archives of the Union, dating back to its foundation in 1951, are be transferred to the Adolph-Würth-Center for the History of Psychology at the University of Würzburg, Germany. An agreement between the Union and the Adolph-Würth-Center was signed at a ceremony in Würzburg on 2 May 2011. The Chancellor of Würzburg University, Enno Kruse, welcomed members of the IUPsyS Executive Committee and other guests to the Adolf-Würth-Center prior to the signing.

The paper-based archives, currently held in a variety of locations in Canada, will be shipped to the Center over the next few months. The Union Secretary-General, Professor Pierre Ritchie, will work with the Director of the Center, Professor Armin Stock, and his colleagues to classify and organize both the paper-based and the electronic archival materials. The agreement finally provides a secure place for the work of the Union to be stored for posterity. In addition, the facilities of the Center will enable access to the materials for future research, whether by students, historians or other scientists.
