Young Investigator Award

The International Union of Psychological Science's Young Investigator Award is given in recognition of a young post-doctoral scientist who has already made a significant contribution to psychological science through excellent research, refereed publications, success in securing research grants, and visibility. Evidence of international collaboration among psychologists or allied disciplines is especially welcome.

Presentation of the award will be at the 32nd International Congress of Psychology (ICP) in Prague, Czech Republic, July 2020. The awardee will also be invited to present an address at the Congress. Funds to cover travel and accommodation related to attending the award ceremony will be provided.

The award is open to young investigators who have completed their PhD within the 10 years preceding the 2020 ICP. Considerations may also be given where a longer period has elapsed due to official leave and/or extenuating circumstances beyond the control of the nominee. Two awards are available in this category: one for young investigators within basic science, and one for those working within applied science.

The Award Jury will be appointed by the Union and will comprise distinguished scholars in the field.

Nomination Process

Nominations should include the following documents:

- a completed nomination form
- curriculum vitae and current contact details of the nominee(s)
- evidence of the PhD and the date of its conferral
- overview of the dissertation and a summary of its findings
- full list of publications, grants and awards
- one primary and two supporting letters of recommendation outlining the merits of the nominee from scientists familiar with the nominee's research and theoretical writings.

Nominations should be received by **May 31, 2019**.

Incomplete or late nominations cannot be considered.
