4th ASEAN Regional Union of Psychologists (ARUPS) Conference & 50th Psychological Association of the Philippines (PAP) Convention

The 4th ASEAN Regional Union of Psychologists (ARUPS) Congress and the Psychological Association of the Philippines (PAP) 50th Annual Convention will be held in Quezon City, Philippines from 23 - 26 October 2013. The theme of the conference is *"Building Hope and Resilience: The Role of ASEAN Psychologists"*.
