1. IUPsyS runs fourth workshop in "Caucasus" series

The Union, with the support of the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD), ran a capacity-building workshop for countries of Central Asia on the topic of Disaster and Bereavement. The workshop, which is the fourth in the series on the topic of conflict and bereavement in the region, was held in Tbilisi, Georgia, on 17-21 November, with participants from six Caucasus and Central Asian countries.
