## CALL FOR EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST IUPSYS PUBLICATIONS REVIEW COMMITTEE

The mission of the <u>International Union of Psychological Science (IUPsyS)</u> is to develop, represent and advance psychology as a basic and applied science nationally, regionally, and internationally. Publications have a central role in the Union achieving its mission and IUPsyS currently publishes the prestigious <u>International Journal of Psychology</u> and has a long history of seminal publications that have influenced the growth and development of psychology globally.

The main outcome of the review will be the development of a strategic plan for publishing that meets the Union's mission. The Publications Review process is expected to involve approximately 12-18 months and will include external experts and representatives from our Publishers. Meetings will be held virtually on a quarterly basis, with opportunities for asynchronous engagement.

We are therefore seeking expressions of interest from individuals from our National and Regional Members to serve on the Publications Review Committee. We are particularly seeking individuals with a strong record of psychological science scholarship and

- Experience in:
  - o different forms of dissemination including social media
  - o understanding of scientific and practitioner publication activities
  - working with Learned Societies especially international organisations on dissemination of science and practice in psychology
  - multi agency/cross disciplinary publication and dissemination
- Commitment to:
  - o diversity and global representation in psychological dissemination
  - scientists and practitioners from all parts of the globe being supported to engage equally with open science as both recipients and contributors
  - o exploring the future of psychological science publications

These positions are voluntary. Those expressing interest should not be currently working in competing capacity and are required to sign the IUPsyS Confidentiality and Conflict of Interest Declaration.

In the first instance, expressions of interest should comprise of:

- a one-page statement to include full name, position and a summary of relevant experience
- one page supporting letter from an IUPsyS National or Regional Member stating the individual has the support of the National or Regional Member. This should be from a person authorised by the National or Regional Member to write such a letter and the letter should state that this was the case.
