The International Union of Psychological Science is pleased to showcase each of the prestigious 2024 Quadrennial 2024 Awards Winners. The Awards will be conferred at the 33rd International Congress of Psychology (ICP2024), Prague, Czech Republic, from July 21 - 26, 2024, where IUPsyS will also celebrate 135 years since the inaugural ICP was held in Paris, France, in 1889.

IUPsyS' *Major Advancement in Psychological Science Prize* is awarded in recognition of a contribution that represents a major advancement in psychology by a scholar or team of scholars of high international reputation.

Professor Susan Gelman is an exemplary recipient of this award. The United States National Committee for Psychological Science, who nominated Professor Gelman, for this award noted in their nomination that:



Dr Gelman's research represents a major advancement in psychology. Her high international reputation can be seen in her numerous awards and invited addresses around the world. The most prominent and enduring influence of Dr Gelman's research has stemmed from her work on psychological essentialism. By providing both a theoretical framework and a rich array of methods and empirical findings, her research has had a direct influence not only on a broad array of subdisciplines within psychology (e.g., developmental, cognitive, social, clinical, educational, cultural), but also on fields outside of psychology (including anthropology, sociology, political science, linguistics, philosophy, and cognitive science).
