The International Union of Psychological Science is pleased to showcase each of the prestigious 2024 Quadrennial 2024 Awards Winners. The Awards will be conferred at the 33rd International Congress of Psychology (ICP2024), Prague, Czech Republic, from July 21 - 26, 2024, where IUPsyS will also celebrate 135 years since the inaugural ICP was held in Paris, France, in 1889.

IUPsyS' *Young Investigator Awards* are given in recognition of a young post-doctoral scientist who has already made a significant contribution to psychological science through excellent research, refereed publications, success in securing research grants, and visibility.

Evidence of international collaboration among psychologists or allied disciplines is especially welcome. Two awards are available in this category: one for young investigators within basic science, and one for those working within applied science.

Dr Langer is a highly worthy recipient of this award. The Federation of German Psychologists' Associations which nominated Dr Langer for this award noted in their nomination that Dr Langer:



Has already made a significant contribution to psychological science, has produced excellent and impactful research in international collaborations, has secured substantial research grants, is internationally visible, and additionally, his research is truly interdisciplinary" "He manages to build bridges between disciplines, most obviously between psychology and computer science. But his work also demonstrates the potential for psychologists to collaborate with philosophers and with legal scholars. The combination of psychology, computer science, philosophy, and law seems to be a signature collaboration of Dr Langer" "it is in this combination that he has secured his largest research grants and has produced some of his most important publications.
